

### Program Overview

The Military Family Employment Advocacy Program (MFEAP) provides employment advocates and services at Florida career centers with high military populations associated with military bases. Those eligible for assistance through this program include spouses and dependents of active military personnel, Florida National guard members and military reservists located in Florida.

Services provided through this program include job search and placement assistance, career planning and counseling, case management, resume assistance, assessment and testing services, interviewing skills training, referral to educational and training programs, job fairs, job clubs, information on Reemployment Assistance, and many other services. Military spouses are also eligible to receive training and other supportive services under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
